

**ADMISSION ELIGIBILITY AND PROCEDURE FOR THE EQUIVALENCE
OF STUDY DIPLOMAS OBTAINED ABROAD BY
ROMANIAN CITIZENS AND
EU MEMBER STATES, EEA AND SWISS CONFEDERATION CITIZENS**

EU Member States, EEA and Swiss Confederation citizens apply for admissions for study programmes at „Lucian Blaga” University of Sibiu under the same conditions as the Romanian citizens. Also, they are subject to the same admission and tuition fees as the Romanian students.

Admission eligibility

The citizens from EU Member States, EEA and Swiss Confederation who wish to study in the Romanian educational institutions must:

- Have the documents proving the citizenship of the respective state
- Have the necessary qualification, attested by educational documents
- Have the necessary educational documents for EU Member States, EEA and Swiss Confederation students, when applying in Romania

Step 1: Recognition of university studies for EU Member States, EEA and Swiss Confederation citizens

The recognition of studies made in home countries is assured by the *National Center of Recognition and Equivalence of Diplomas (CNRED)* of the Ministry of Education, according to the law.

- For recognition of preuniversity studies (**Baccalaureate diploma or equivalent**) you must comply the following procedure established by National Center for Recognition and Equivalence of Diplomas
- For recognition of higher education studies (**University diploma or equivalent** for the admission to master/doctoral studies) you must comply the following procedure established by National Center for Recognition and Equivalence of Diplomas

Step 2: Prepare the application file for university studies with the following documents

- **Photocopy of the recognition certificate** of studies issue by National Center for Recognition and Equivalence of Diplomas
- **Baccalaureate diploma** or its equivalent
 - Photocopy of the original if the study document is issued in Romanian, English, French, Spanish, Italian language
 - Photocopy of the original and certified translation in Romanian language for the documents issued in other languages

• **Transcript** for the last 2 years of high school completed abroad, with subjects and marks/points obtained:

- copy, if the study document is issued in Romanian, English, French, Spanish, Italian language
- copy and certified translation (in original) in Romanian for the documents issued in other languages

- **Birth certificate** – Photocopy of the certified translation
- **Photocopy of the identification paper:** passport, proof of legal name change (if applicable, photocopy for documents in Romanian language / English / French / Spanish / Italian, and certified translation in Romanian for other languages)
- **Photocopy of the medical certificate** (in a widespread international language) to prove that the person to be registered for studies does not suffer from contagious diseases or other illnesses.
- **Portrait photography**

**The Hague Apostille is requested for diplomas from countries which are parties to the Hague Apostille, issued by the competent authorities in the issuing countries. The Hague Apostille is requested for diplomas from Italy, Greece, Spain, Portugal and Cyprus.*

Diplomas issued in countries which are not parties to the Hague Apostille Convention shall be authenticated or accompanied by an authentication certificate from by the competent authorities in the issuing countries;

Legalization/Authentication is done by the Ministry of Foreign Affairs from the issuing country, the Embassy/Consular Office of Romania in the issuing country and the Romanian Ministry of Foreign Affairs or by the Ministry of Foreign Affairs in the issuing country, the issuing country's Embassy/Consular Office in Romania and the Romanian Ministry of Foreign Affairs; for countries where Romania does not have a diplomatic mission or countries which do not have diplomatic missions in Romania, the study documents shall be legalized by the Ministry of Education and the Ministry of Foreign Affairs from the issuing country;

Legalization/Authentication exemption is allowed under the law of an international treaty to which Romania is party or on a reciprocity basis.
